

I-CARE Achievers Programme

The motto of The Chinese University of Hong Kong (CUHK) is “Through Learning and Temperance to Virtue”. It could be perceived as the prototype of “Whole-person Development”. To motivate students to take solid action in pursuit of whole-person development, the *I-CARE Achievers Programme* is rolled out in 2018-19 and will be run for three years. This programme is chiefly sponsored by Tin Ka Ping Foundation and overseen by Prof. Joseph Sung, Former Vice-Chancellor and President of CUHK. It is divided into two parts - “Value Exploration Series” and “Core Group Nurture”. While the former is open for all CUHK students and staff, the latter will serve 30 to 50 students a year.

Ms. Christine Ma, Founder & Chairperson of Character Education Foundation and Principal of JEMS Learning House has been invited to serve as advisor of this section.
